

## ILM Level 2 Award in Introduction to Mentoring Skills

This ILM Level 2 Award aims to equip individuals with the skills and knowledge to understand and undertake effective mentoring.

### Benefits for Individuals

- Develop an understanding of the role and nature of mentoring
- Utilise mentoring skills to support the development of others
- Understand how to organise and undertake mentoring activities
- Reflect on your own performance as a mentor

### The programme

**Induction:** one hour (within first workshop)

**Workshops:** One full day and one half day mandatory workshop on:

- Understanding mentoring and developing mentoring skills
- Planning and undertaking mentoring practise

**Coaching:** telephone and email coaching if required

**Assessment:** to gain the qualification you will need to complete the following:

- An assignment
- Practise your mentoring skills with an individual, either in the workplace or outside. This activity will need to be undertaken for at least three hours, over more than one session. The sessions must be documented and reflected on in order to achieve the qualification.
